

## **INFORMATION**

### **ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE 13 OF THE PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION CODE (D.LGS. N. 196/2003)**

This information is made by the Regional Council of Piedmont, based in Turin 15, Vittorio Alfieri street, according to the Legislative Decree 30th June 2003 n. 196 “Personal Data Protection Code” (below “The Code”) who, regulating the right to the protection of personal data, has foreseen that the person concerned receive a preventive information and, in case is demanded, grant explicit consent to the usage of his personal data.

#### **1. Source of personal data**

Personal data, object of processing by Piedmont Regional Council according to this report, are collected through the website [www.piemontevisualcontest.eu](http://www.piemontevisualcontest.eu) (the “website”), on the occasion of the filling, by you, of the registration form to the contest “PIEDMONT VISUAL CONTEST” (the “Contest”). These data are the object of processing, according to the regulations mentioned above and to the privacy obligations.

#### **2. Purposes of data processing**

These data are processed:

- (i) for your registration and participation to the contest and to allow Piedmont Regional Council to fulfil its obligations according to the contest regulations and procedures therein outlined (for example for the communication to the jury);
- (ii) for publication and disclosure of the proponents names through the official website of the contest [www.piemontevisualcontest.eu](http://www.piemontevisualcontest.eu) and/or within connected channels (included promotional enterprises coming from Piedmont regional council through any means of communication, and even in the occasion of events, congresses and meetings).

Any other data disclosure possibility, not imposed by law or explicitly authorized by you, is excluded.

#### **3. Processing conditions**

The processing of your personal data is carried out by electronic means and logics connected to the purposes of processing and to guarantee security and privacy of the same data, which will be handled and protected in places where access is under control. Specifically information systems and programs are framed in such a way as to limit to the bare minimum the personal data processing. In any case the personal data are protected and controlled in a way such as to reduce to a minimum the risks of loss, not authorized access or not allowed processing or not corresponding to the purposes of the collection.

#### **4. Obligatory or optional nature of data supply and consequences of a possible refusal**

Remembering the purposes expressed in point 2, we inform you that the data supply is not obligatory, but necessary for your enrolment and participation to the contest following the conditions described in the contest regulations. The prospective refusal of supplying the demanded data implies the objective impossibility to enrol and participate to the contest, and specifically the impossibility to give you the prize.

## **5. Subjects and categories to which data can be communicated**

To reach the purposes mentioned above, your personal data may be communicated to the following categories of subjects in Italy or abroad (even to states out of the European Union) who are suitably named Responsible or persons in charge:

- . Piedmont Regional Council civil servants and consultants;
- . PIEDMONT VISUAL CONTEST organizing committee members;
- . jury members

## **6. Data controller and data processor**

Piedmont Regional Council is the Data Controller based in Turin 15, Vittorio Alfieri street 10121.

## **7. The person concerned rights**

We inform you that the personal data protection rules entrust people concerned the possibility to exercise the rights provided for by Section 7 of the Code entirely quoted as follows, writing to <mailto:piemontvisualcontest@top-ix.org>

### **Section 7**

#### ***(Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights)***

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.

2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed:

- a) of the source of the personal data;
- b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
- c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
- d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2);
- e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.

3. A data subject shall have the right to obtain:

- a) updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
- b) erasure, transformation in anonymous way or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
- c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.

4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,

a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;

b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
